No Obedience Offered

Rules:

1. All pure-bred salukis are eligible to enter this Match. This includes desert-breds.
2. Champions of record may not compete in regular conformation classes.
3. Professional handlers may only handle dogs that they own or co-own.

Ribbons & Trophies

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place and the 1st place winner in each class will receive a trophy. Trophies and rosettes will be awarded for Best Puppy, Best Opposite Puppy, Best Adult, Best Opposite Adult and Best in Match

Perpetual Trophy

The Saluki Club of Greater San Francisco's Best in Match Trophy will be awarded to the Saluki judged Best in Match and will be decided by the match judge between the Best Puppy and the Best Adult. The trophy is the property of SCGSF and may be taken only by a voting member in good standing. A picture of the trophy will

be presented to an associate member or a non-member that is awarded Best in Match. The trophy is to be returned to the SCGSF prior to, or on the day of the next match.

CANINE GOOD CITIZEN TEST SUNDAY SEPTEMBER 12, 2010

Following Match Judging (test items – see - http://www.akc.org/events/cgc/training_testing.cfm \$10.00 Testing Fee

All dogs over 6 months of age are welcome.

The dog must wear a well-fitted buckle or slip collar of leather, fabric or chain. All tests will be performed on a leather or fabric lead. Please bring your dog's comb or brush.

Testing will be performed by AKC Evaluator Pam Bechtold.

Qualifying dogs will receive an official copy of the test form which can be sent to AKC, along with a \$5.00 recording fee, to receive AKC's official CGC certificate suitable for framing. You may register at the Match.

The CGC consists of 10 tests of skills needed by any and all well-mannered dogs. All the exercises are done on leash.

Test 1. Accepting a friendly stranger

The dog will allow a friendly stranger (in this case, me) to approach it and speak to the handler (in this case, you) in a natural everyday situation.

Test 2. Sitting politely for petting

The dog will allow a friendly stranger (me) to pet it while it is out with its handler.

Test 3. Appearance and grooming

The dog will welcome being groomed and examined and will permit someone (me) to do so. Both feet and head must be able to be touched.

Test 4. Out for a walk (walking on loose lead)

The handler/dog team will take a short 'walk' to show that the dog is in control while walking on a leash. I'll call a short pattern for this exercise, i.e. right turn, left turn, stop, go...

Test 5. Walking through a crowd.

The dog and handler walk around and pass close to several people to demonstrate that the dog can move about politely in pedestrian traffic, and

is under control in public places.

Test 6. Sit and down on command, and staying in place

The dog will respond to the handler's commands to sit, down, and will remain in the place commanded by the handler (either in a sit or a down)

Test 7. Coming when called

The dog will come when called by the handler. The handler will walk 10 feet from the dog, turn to face the dog, and call the dog.

Test 8. Reaction to another dog

To demonstrate that the dog can behave politely around other dogs, two handlers and their dogs approach each other from a distance of about 20 feet, stop, shake hands, and exchange pleasantries, and continue on for about 10 feet. The tested dog should not over-react to the presence of the other dog. (I prefer that the 'other' dog be a non-saluki.)

Test 9. Reaction to distraction

The dog should remain confident when faced with common distracting situations (the evaluator will select 2 distractions). Could be a person on crutches, someone with a walker, a child in a stroller, etc.

Test 10. Supervised separation

This test demonstrates that the dog can be left with a trusted person and will maintain training and good manners. The owner will go out of sight for 3 minutes. Excessive whining, barking, pulling will cause failure.

Everyone should bring their dog's brush or comb. The dogs must wear a buckle collar or slip collar (no harness, gentle leader, prong, or the like).

Any indication of aggression will cause failure.
